Pathways to Success

Whether you are following a path that leads to the workforce, to college, or somewhere else, WJSHS has programs that can lead you in the right direction. Working with the community and industry leaders, we have developed educational pathways that can prepare you for success in the fields you are interested in.

Manufacturing & Engineering Pathway

Developed in partnership with local businesses, this pathway emphasizes skills and problem-solving tactics that directly translate to working in advanced manufacturing, whether you are interested in employment directly out of high school or want to pursue an engineering degree.

Certified Nursing Assistant Pathway

The CNA course lays the groundwork for caring for patients, while familiarizing students with the human body and its functions. Students receive training in patient care and opportunities to work directly with professionals. Students are also prepared to take the Nurse Assistant Certification test.

Fire Science Pathway

WJSHS is the first Massachusetts high school to offer a pathway in firefighting and life-saving techniques. Students learn theory and then put it into practice, extinguishing fires and rescuing people from simulated situations.



Innovative Classrooms

WJSHS is a close-knit community with small class sizes. Our teachers and students build supportive relationships together that focus on meeting individual student needs. We innovate and adapt to our students in ways that go above and beyond what other, larger schools can offer.

Our low student-to-teacher ratios help increase personalized instruction and our teachers are always finding new ways to engage each of our students. Our educators tailor their teaching and coursework around the needs and interests of each student in their classes, ensuring that curriculums stay relevant, and the coursework “sticks” with students as they move from class to class.
