Social Expectations

1. Ware High School students will demonstrate respect for self, others, and our environment

<i>1a. Does the student work to his or her potential?</i>	
4 Exceeds all standards	Student always works to potential.
3 Meets all standards	Student usually works to potential.
2 Meets some standards	Student sometimes works to potential.
1 Does not meet standards	Student rarely works to potential.
0 No attempt made	Student never works to potential.

<i>1b. Does the student dress appropriately for school?</i>	
4 Exceeds all standards	Student always dresses appropriately.
3 Meets all standards	Student usually dresses appropriately.
2 Meets some standards	Student sometimes dresses appropriately.
1 Does not meet standards	Student rarely dresses appropriately.
0 No attempt made	Student never dresses appropriately.

<i>1c. Does the student support the success of other students?</i>	
4 Exceeds all standards	Student always supports the success of other students.
3 Meets all standards	Student usually supports the success of other students.
2 Meets some standards	Student sometimes supports the success of other students.
1 Does not meet standards	Student rarely supports the success of other students.
0 No attempt made	Student never supports the success of other students.

<i>1d. Does the student solve disputes peacefully?</i>	
4 Exceeds all standards	Student always solves disputes peacefully.
3 Meets all standards	Student usually solves disputes peacefully.
2 Meets some standards	Student sometimes solves disputes peacefully.
1 Does not meet standards	Student rarely solves disputes peacefully.
0 No attempt made	Student never solves disputes peacefully.

<i>1e. Does the student respect personal space and property of students, staff and school.</i>	
4 Exceeds all standards	Students always respects personal space and property of students, staff and school.
3 Meets all standards	Students usually respects personal space and property of students, staff and school.
2 Meets some standards	Students sometimes respects personal space and property of students, staff and school.
1 Does not meet standards	Students rarely respects personal space and property of students, staff and school.
0 No attempt made	Students never respects personal space and property of students, staff and school.

2. Ware High School students will take responsibility for their behavior and education.

<i>2a. Does the student behave appropriately?</i>	
4 Exceeds all standards	Student always follows the rules outlined in the behavior policy.
3 Meets all standards	Student usually follows the rules outlined in the behavior policy.
2 Meets some standards	Student sometimes follows the rules outlined in the behavior policy.
1 Does not meet standards	Student rarely follows the rules outlined in the behavior policy.
0 No attempt made	Student never follows the rules outlined in the behavior policy.

<i>2b. Does the student do all homework as assigned?</i>	
4 Exceeds all standards	All homework is completed and done in a detailed manner.
3 Meets all standards	All homework is completed.
2 Meets some standards	75% of homework is completed.
1 Does not meet standards	50% of homework is completed.
0 No attempt made	Student makes no effort to do assignments.

<i>2c. Does the students do all classwork as assigned?</i>	
4 Exceeds all standards	All classwork is completed and done in a detailed manner.
3 Meets all standards	All classwork is completed.
2 Meets some standards	75% of classwork is completed.
1 Does not meet standards	50% of classwork is completed.
0 No attempt made	Student makes no effort to do assignments.

<i>2d. Does the student participate in class discussions?</i>	
4 Exceeds all standards	Student always participates and enhances the discussion.
3 Meets all standards	Student participates in class discussions.
2 Meets some standards	Student participates in 75% of class discussions.
1 Does not meet standards	Student participates in 50% of class discussions.
0 No attempt made	Student makes no effort to participate in class discussions.

<i>2e. Does the student plan effectively and efficiently for the future?</i>	
4 Exceeds all standards	Student chooses rigorous courses, takes ownership and is in pursuit of a career path.
3 Meets all standards	Student chooses challenging courses and has a career path.

2 Meets some standards	Student works on career path when assisted.
1 Does not meet standards	Student takes occasional interest in career planning.
0 No attempt made	Student makes no attempt to form future plans.

3. Ware High School students will accept the consequences of their actions.

4 Exceeds all standards	Student accepts responsibility for actions without explanation and inquires how to become a better citizen.
3 Meets all standards	Student accepts responsibility for actions without explanation.
2 Meets some standards	Student has some difficulty but accepts partial responsibility for actions with explanation.
1 Does not meet standards	Student has difficulty understanding the relationship between actions and consequences.
0 No attempt made	Student blames others for his/her circumstances.

4. Ware High School Students will abide by school and societal boundaries.

<i>4a. Does the student follow school rules?</i>	
4 Exceeds all standards	Student follows all rules and asks as a positive role model for others.
3 Meets all standards	Student follows all rules.
2 Meets some standards	Student sometimes follows school rules.
1 Does not meet standards	Student rarely follows school rules.
0 No attempt made	Student fails to follow school rules.

<i>4b. Does the student follow local, state and federal norms?</i>	
4 Exceeds all standards	Student is recognized as being a good citizen by participating in societal events.
3 Meets all standards	Student is a good citizen.
2 Meets some standards	Student is occasionally in trouble outside of school and infractions are reported to school.
1 Does not meet standards	Student is frequently in trouble outside of school and infractions are beginning to affect schoolwork.
0 No attempt made	Student fails to abide by the law and schoolwork is continuously being affected.

Civic Expectations

1. Ware High School Students will attend school regularly and participate in their education.

<i>1a. Students will attend school.</i>	
4 Exceeds all standards	Student has perfect attendance.
3 Meets all standards	Student has missed one to five days.
2 Meets some standards	Student has missed six to ten days or less.
1 Does not meet standards	Student has missed more than ten days.
0 No attempt made	Student has missed eleven to twenty days.

<i>1b. Students will be on time for school.</i>	
4 Exceeds all standards	Student is never tardy.
3 Meets all standards	Student is tardy to school one to five times.
2 Meets some standards	Student is tardy to school six to ten times.
1 Does not meet standards	Student is tardy to school eleven to twenty times.
0 No attempt made	Student is tardy 21 or more times to school.

<i>1c. Students will participate in their education</i>	
4 Exceeds all standards	Student goes above and beyond the expectations of participation in his/her entire education.
3 Meets all standards	Student participates in his/her education by regularly by attending school, completing work and becoming involved in the education community.
2 Meets some standards	Student participates in his/her education with standard some absences and/or some incomplete work.
1 Does not meet standards	Student rarely participates, is absent frequently and fails to complete most work.
0 No attempt made	Student never participates in any aspect of their education.

2. Ware High School students will develop knowledge and skills to become active citizens.

4 Exceeds all standards	Student demonstrates and awareness of and regularly participates in local, state or world affairs.
3 Meets all standards	Student demonstrates an awareness of and participates in some local, state and world affairs.
2 Meets some standards	Student demonstrates some awareness of local, state and world affairs.

1 Does not meet standards	Student demonstrates little awareness of local, state and world affairs.
0 No attempt made	Student does not demonstrate any awareness of local, state and world affairs.

3. Ware High School students will develop an awareness of diverse cultures, societies and ways of life.

<i>3a. Ware students will have civic awareness.</i>	
4 Exceeds all standards	Student takes an active part in choosing classes that lead to civic and social awareness.
3 Meets all standards	Student takes a passive role in choosing classes that lead to civic and social awareness.
2 Meets some standards	Student is enrolled in classes that promote civic and social awareness.
1 Does not meet standards	Student is not enrolled in classes that promote civic and social awareness.
0 No attempt made	Student shows adversity toward taking classes that promote civic and social awareness.

<i>3b. Ware students have respect for diversity.</i>	
4 Exceeds all standards	Student demonstrates and promotes respect for cultural diversity in their community.
3 Meets all standards	Student demonstrates respect for cultural diversity in their community.
2 Meets some standards	Student is aware of a need for respect for cultural diversity in the community but does not always participate.
1 Does not meet standards	Student is ignorant of the importance of respect for diversity.
0 No attempt made	Student shows total disregard in demonstrating respect for social diversity.
